Job Summary:

The Deckineer will greet all guests and ensure each guest is attended to in an appropriate manner ensuring consistently high levels of safety, quality, service, and guest satisfaction, while maintaining a high level of profitability.

Essential Functions:

Deckineer will ensure adherence to procedures detailed in the Management Guide.

- Is directly responsible to the Captain and is considered the First Mate.
- Thorough pre-cruise preparation, and adherence to cruise scripts
- Participate in pre-cruise meetings regarding the cruise (special needs, boarding procedures, etc.)
- Adherence to all Coast Guard rules and regulations
- Gather pertinent cruise event details from the other departments to ensure special guest requests are fulfilled
- Ensure that staff and guests adhere to all safety standards and procedures
- Participate in the execution of the Safety Program, including emergency drills
- Participate in the proper maintenance of all ship's systems and boarding facilities including but not limited to gangways, diesel, hydraulic, pneumatic, electrical, water (potable, raw, black, and gray), fire suppression, communications, and navigation



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Essential Functions Continued:

- Ensure adherence to Coast Guard rules and regulations, and other federal and local rules and regulations
- Ensure strict compliance to Emergency Response Plan
- Execute other projects as assigned by management
- Participate in collateral duties as assigned by RDC Management: uniforms, crew training, safety training, and routine vessel maintenance
- Develop positive working relationships with Captain, department heads and peers
- Complete all shift records: checklist, and documentation of safety training
- Attend all scheduled meetings

Accountabilities:

The Deckineer will personally contribute to the unforgettable guest experience, be favorably viewed by Captain and peers, and be swift and efficient in the execution of their assigned duties. Performance will be measured by quality, service, safety, management evaluation, and feedback from RDC management, peers, and guests.

Job requirements and physical requirements:

- High school diploma or GED equivalent required
- Minimum of —preferably to include two (2) years as a Deckhand/Engineer with an outstanding record
- Some maintenance-mechanical boat equipment experience required
- Ability to bend, squat, stoop, crawl, and knee
- Perform prolonged standing
- Ability to turn head from side to side and about the vertical axis
- Ability to turn body at the waist from side to side and about the vertical axis
- Lift/push/pull 50 lbs. to 75 lbs. on an occasional basis
- Lift/push/pull up to 20 lbs. on a frequent basis
- Must have the ability to climb in a safe manner (climbing as a minimum includes stairs, scaffolding, ladders and ramps)
- Demonstrate the ability to safely and appropriately use required tools and equipment



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Job requirements and physical requirements continued:

- Demonstrate good balance while working on uneven surfaces and maneuvering obstacles
- Possess sufficient handgrip and coordination to carry and operate tools and equipment
- Ability to utilize personal protective equipment (closed toe shoes, safety glasses, ear plugs, goggles, respirator, safety harness, safety lines, floatation gear, etc.) safely per OSHA standards
- Ability to work in inclement weather conditions including heat, humidity and sun
- Able to work in an environment where you are occasionally exposed to fumes and/or airborne particles, toxic or caustic chemicals
- Ability to enter small spaces, openings and work in confined spaces
- Able to respond to verbal and audible sounds/commands directly with the Captain
- Able to utilize adequate visual skills
- Ability to fully extend the arm or arms while reaching overhead, reaching out, reaching to the side and reaching down with tools and/or equipment
- Ability to perceive attributes of an object/materials such as size, shape, temperature and texture
- Observe all safety signs, notices and understand safety procedures, and attend safety meetings
- Eager and energetic person with the ability to work unsupervised
- Professional appearance, and the ability to follow directions in a professional manner
- Team player attitude is necessary
- Detailed working knowledge of all ship's systems and their proper maintenance: gangways, diesel, hydraulic, pneumatic, electrical, water (potable, raw, black, and gray), fire suppression, communications, and navigation Marlinspike seamanship and line handling
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- Basic navigation (including radar, chart plotter) and boat handling
- Survival, safety, and damage control equipment
- Emergency and casualty control
- Watchstanding and communications.
- First aid
- Able to communicate effectively in oral and written form



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Job requirements and physical requirements continued:

- Able to effectively deal with internal and external guests some of whom will require high levels of patience tact and diplomacy
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships
- Ability to analyze and solve problems
- Per DOT regulations, must submit to pre-employment and ongoing random drug and alcohol testing
- Each candidate must possess a Transportation Workers Identification Credential (TWIC™) in good standing.
- Each candidate must submit to a pre-employment background check.
- Per USCG regulations, must be a US Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Must have a valid US Driver's License and pass a Motor Vehicle Record history check
